### **Energiequelle GmbH once again awarded CrefoZert credit rating certificate**

**Creditreform awarded the Brandenburg company an "excellent credit rating" for the fifth time in a row**

The certificate is issued by Creditreform, a leading German expert in assessing the credit standing of companies. Michael Raschemann, Managing Director of Energiequelle, was available for the survey and provided an insight into the current business situation and future prospects of the company. As part of the audit, Energiequelle demonstrated an excellent credit standing structure and met all certification criteria.

Only approx. 1.7% of German companies meet CrefoZert's strict criteria. Energiequelle GmbH's certificate is valid until October 2021.
